

Flow of Body collection (Coroner's case)

Patient passed away



Relatives will be informed for body identification and interview with Pathologist
Location: Mortuary, B3, Block S, United Christian Hospital
Pathologist will explain the Coroner's procedures and post-mortem examinations * Relatives could apply for an exemption of autopsy through the Medical Officer of Hospital Pathology Department. However, the Coroner's Court holds the final decision.
The following documents are required: 1. Original copy of the deceased's identification document 2. Original copy of the responsible relative's identification document

Apply for cremation / burial
Location: The Joint Office (For cremation) / Respective cemetery office (For burial)
The following documents must be presented: 1. Original copy of the deceased's identification document 2. Original copy of the responsible relative's identification document 3. Certificate of Order Authorizing Burial/Cremation of Body (Form 11)



To make appointment for collection of the body / Reservation of the Ceremony Hall (if needed)
Call or contact the Death Certification Office (B1, Block S)
